Hastings and Prince Edward Counties/ August 24, 2018

Hastings Prince Edward Public Health monitors bathing beach water quality at designated public beaches within our jurisdiction through the collection and analyses of water samples for the presence of *E.coli* bacteria. When *E.coli* bacteria levels exceed the provincial standard, the bathing beach is considered to be unsafe for swimming and the following warning sign is posted at the beach:

Unsafe for swimming
High levels of bacteria in these waters may pose a risk to your health
