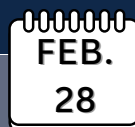

2023 Interim Tax Bill

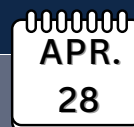
DUE DATES:

Please find enclosed your Interim Tax Bill. Your interim taxes are due in two installments. This is due on the last business day of February and April.

Even if you do not receive a tax bill or statement, you are still responsible for paying taxes and are liable for penalty and interest charges on late or missed payments.

A second Final Tax Bill will be delivered in late May/early June and will contain the final two installments, due the last business day of July and September.

BILL AMOUNTS:

How was my 2023 interim tax bill calculated?
Your 2023 interim tax bill is based on 50 percent of your 2022 final taxes.

NEW HOME OWNERS?

If your home is newly constructed, your tax bill may reflect only the land portion. At a later date you will receive an Supplemental Tax Bill for the building portion, resulting in a higher tax bill. A Supplemental Assessment Notice will be sent to you by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC), followed by a Supplementary Tax Bill from Centre Hastings. Please plan for payment of all applicable taxes.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Making a Payment?

The Municipality has a number of payment options for your convenience as noted below

1. Pre-Authorized Payments (PAP)

A) Monthly Program (12 installments, on the 30th day of each month (28th February)

B) Due Date Program (4 installments found on this pamphlet)

2. Online through Your Bank/Mobile App

You can pay your tax bill at most banks through internet banking. Pay your bill ahead of the due date to allow enough time for the bank to transfer the funds to the Municipality. Search payee "Centre Hastings", use your 19-digit roll number as the account number.

2023 LEAF AND YARD WASTE PICKUP

Put your leaf and yard waste out on your regular pickup day during the following weeks:

Rural:

Week of May 1st
Week of October 16th
Week of October 30th

Accepted:

- ✓ Grass clippings
- ✓ Branches or twigs
- ✓ Leaves
- ✓ Plant material (no soil)

Madoc Village:

Week of May 8th
Week of October 23rd
Week of November 6th

Not Accepted:

- X Sod/soil
- X Stumps or root balls
- X Rocks, stones, etc.
- X Plastic of any kind

Have your leaf and yard waste out by 7am on your regular pickup day during the weeks as noted above. Tie brush into bundles no longer than 3ft. with material no larger than 2 inches in diameter. Only use paper yard waste bags. Each bag must not weigh more than 40lbs (18kg). Roll the bags down to keep out rain and snow.

Outside of the above dates, the Landfill Site at 106968 Highway 7 will accept your leaf and yard waste at no charge.

MAILING ADDRESS CHANGES

Moving? Prevent a misdirected tax bill notice by letting us know as soon as possible. Homeowners must ensure their property and contact information is up-to-date.
